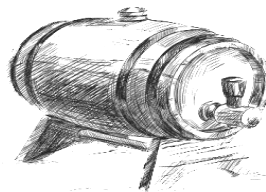

## Speyside

Speyside, widely regarded as the heart of whisky production in Scotland, is home to the highest concentration of distilleries—more than half of the country's distilleries are nestled within this region. Although geographically part of the Highlands, Speyside is considered a distinct whisky-producing area due to its unique characteristics. The region takes its name from the River Spey, which winds its way through the heart of Speyside, with many distilleries using the river's pure waters in their production process. Speyside Scotch whiskies are often hailed as the country's most complex, renowned for their delicate sweetness and elegant array of flavours and aromas.

## Highland

The Highlands is the largest whisky-producing region in Scotland, known for its wide variety of flavours. Whiskies from this region tend to be full-bodied, with bold notes of peat and smoke. Given the vastness of the Highlands, the whiskies can vary greatly in character. From the robust, heathery, and spicy profiles of the Northern Highlands to the lighter, fruity expressions of the Southern Highlands, there's a Highland whisky to suit every palate.

## Islands

In the world of Scotch whisky, "the Islands" refers to the whisky-producing islands located in the north and west of Scotland. This includes Mainland, the largest island in the Orkneys; the islands of Mull and Jura in the Inner Hebrides; Lewis in the Outer Hebrides; and the island of Arran, nestled between the Campbeltown peninsula and the mainland in the Firth of Clyde. Islay and Skye, also in the Inner Hebrides, are often considered separately. While each island has its unique flavour profile, all Island whiskies share common characteristics of peat and a distinct salinity, influenced by their proximity to the sea.

## Lowland

The Lowlands region, located at the southernmost tip of Scotland, is home to just three remaining operating distilleries. This flat, mountainous-free landscape produces Scotch whiskies that are generally considered the lightest-bodied of all the Single Malts.

## Islay

Pronounced "eye-luh," Islay Scotch is renowned for being the smokiest and most intensely flavoured of the single malts—some even say it tastes of the sea. This bold character is thought to stem from the region's exposure to the fierce winds and rugged seas of Scotland's west coast.

## Ireland

Irish whiskies are often associated with smoothness, fruitiness, and the distinctive triple distillation process, and while many fit this description, it doesn't tell the whole story. Irish single pot still whiskey, for example, is made from a blend of both malted and unmalted barley, distilled in a pot still, and will be labelled as such.

## Japan

Japanese whisky, inspired by Scotch, shares both craft and spelling—noticeably without the "e," unlike American or Irish whiskey. It follows the Scotch tradition of double distilling malted or peated barley and aging it in wood barrels. Japanese whisky also tends to be drier, smokier, and peatier, but its flavour profile varies widely. Some bottles are earthy and peaty, while others are subtler. What unites them all is a commitment to perfection, with a constant drive to refine and innovate their whisky-making craft.

## American (Bourbon)

In the late 1700s, as America took shape, a wave of immigrants with distilling expertise from Western Europe and beyond arrived, bringing European techniques to New World crops. This fusion gave birth to American whiskey. Entrepreneurs like George Dickel, who arrived from Germany in 1844, were thrilled by the fertile valleys ideal for spirit production. Settling in Tennessee, Dickel called it "a distiller's dream," thanks to pure limestone water and abundant grains. U.S. law now dictates that all American whiskey must come from a fermented mash of grain, with specific rules for each type. Bourbon, Rye, and Tennessee whiskey dominate, but other grain-based whiskeys, like corn and barley, are on the rise.

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## Speyside

### **Aberlour Double Cask 12Y (SM)**

This rich liquid draws its bold character from Spanish oak oloroso sherry butts, infusing it with floral aromas, sweet raisin notes, and a delightful spicy nuttiness. Expect smooth, full-bodied flavours with hints of plum fruitiness and a subtle touch of oak.

### **Aberlour Sherry Cask 12Y (SM)**

A perfect showcase of how crisp citrus is mellowed through double cask maturation. Traditional oak and sherry butts come together to create a beautifully balanced flavour, with smooth notes of tangy orange, red apple, liquorice, and almond.

### **Aultmore 12Y (SM)**

Unveiled in 2014 as part of Dewar's Last Great Malts, this crisp and vibrant single malt delivers layers of vanilla, honey, and bright citrus. A gentle grassy note lingers on the finish, adding depth to its smooth, refreshing character.

### **Balvenie original Cask Finish (SM)**

This classic made history as the world's first cask-finished single malt Scotch. First aged in American oak barrels, it's then transferred to another cask for the perfect finish. Expect sweet, syrupy flavours with hints of vanilla, oak, and ginger spice.

### **Balvenie Double Wood 12Y (SM)**

With a distinctive character from maturation in two different wood type casks, each stage adds unique qualities to this single malt. The result is a smooth blend of soft oloroso notes, honey, and vanilla, with hints of nuttiness, sherry, and a touch of cinnamon.

### **Balvenie Triple Cask 12Y (SM)**

A masterful blend of whisky from three distinct casks. Oloroso sherry butts add subtle spice and depth, first-fill bourbon barrels bring rich vanilla sweetness, and traditional American oak casks lay the foundation with smooth honeyed notes. The result is a perfectly balanced, complex single malt.

### **Benriach Quarter (SM)**

Initially aged in bourbon barrels, then given a second maturation in bespoke quarter casks, allowing greater wood interaction. This intensifies buttery, woody flavours, complemented by notes of apricot jam, cooked pear, brown sugar, and creamy barley.

### **Benromach 10Y (SM)**

Matured in a classic mix of first-fill bourbon and sherry casks, this whisky opens with dried fruit, fresh vanilla, and subtle smoky notes. Hints of barley, herbs, and grassiness emerge, balanced by rich malt and a warm touch of ground ginger.

### **Cardhu Gold Reserve (SM)**

Aged in hand-picked toasted American oak casks, this smooth and well-rounded single malt offers a rich honeyed character. Layers of ripe orchard fruits, toffee, and warm spice are complemented by a subtle oakiness, creating a balanced and approachable dram with a soft, lingering finish.

### **Crabbie 12Y (SM)**

Released by John Crabbie & Co., this whisky boasts a rich, full flavour with a buttery-sweet balance. Notes of sweet honey, grilled orange, and green tea add depth, leading to a smooth, well-rounded finish.

### **Cragganmore 12Y (SM)**

This rich, slightly floral whisky is aged in a mix of American oak and European oak casks, enhancing its depth and complexity. Barley notes mingle with honey, stone fruits, chestnuts, walnuts, almonds, and a touch of berries, creating a smooth and layered dram.

### **Craigellachie (SM)**

Bold and distinctive, it stands apart with its robust, fruity flavour, shaped by traditional worm tub condensers for a bold, old-school character. Aged in a mix of ex-bourbon and ex-sherry casks, it develops rich notes of tropical fruit, malted barley, and toasted oak, with a distinctive hint of sulphur.

### **Fable Hound Chapter 5 10Y (SM)**

From the Mannochnore Distillery in Elgin, established in 1971, this whisky is incredibly sweet and full-bodied. Bursting with rich, sugary fruitiness, it offers a lush medley of juicy fruits wrapped in smooth, floral honey.

### **Glenfiddich General Information**

Glenfiddich, meaning 'Valley of the Deer' in Scottish Gaelic, is represented by a stag on every bottle. Owned and produced by William Grant & Sons in Dufftown, it has been bottled with the same spring water since 1887.

### **Glenfiddich Rich Oak 14Y (SM)**

A captivating single malt, matured in a combination of American and European oak casks. The result is a harmonious blend of rich, spicy oak, dried fruit, and hints of vanilla, offering a smooth yet complex flavour profile. Aged to perfection, it's a standout for those seeking a bold and well-rounded whisky.

### **Glenfiddich Vat 02 (SM)**

From the Perpetual Collection, where Glenfiddich whiskies are in constant motion with vats that never empty. This expression is deliciously smooth and silky, with the sweetness of the spirit and the spice of Spanish oak blending to create a complex, evolving flavour that unfolds in the glass.

### **Glenfiddich Select Cask (SM)**

It is matured in a combination of ex-bourbon, European oak, and red wine casks, using Glenfiddich's Solera Vat technique to create a smooth, well-balanced dram. Expect notes of sweet vanilla, ripe fruit, oak spice, and subtle citrus, with a silky, lingering finish.

### **Glenlivet General Information**

In 1824, George Smith became the first legal distiller in Glenlivet, Scotland, breaking away from illegal stills. Fifty years later, he secured the exclusive right to call his whisky "THE Glenlivet," establishing its legacy as the original Speyside single malt and the benchmark for all others.

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## **Glenlivet 12Y (SM)**

A 12-year-old single malt whisky aged in traditional oak, then finished in American oak casks, adding smooth vanilla notes and a subtle touch of pineapple for a perfectly balanced, fruity finish.

## **Glenlivet 15Y (SM)**

Glenlivet 15-year-old is finished in Limousin French Oak, the same wood used for many Cognacs. It offers rich notes of fruit, almonds, and sweet spice, creating a beautifully complex flavour.

## **Glenlivet Caribbean Reserve (SM)**

Caribbean Reserve features a portion of whisky finished in casks that once held Caribbean rum, adding layers of ripe tropical fruit, brown sugar, and cinnamon pastries for a rich, indulgent flavour.

## **Glenlivet Founder's Reserve (SM)**

Created in 2014, a smooth, well-balanced single malt with a rich, fruity character. Aged in a combination of traditional oak and first-fill American oak casks, its creamy texture blends notes of sweet pear, citrus, and a hint of vanilla, leading to a soft, elegant finish.

## **Glenlivet French Oak (SM)**

This 15-Year-Old whisky offers sweet almond spice and an exotic character from maturation in French oak casks. Bold oak spices of cloves, nutmeg, and fennel, with sweet raisins, nougat, and cinnamon.

## **Glenlivet Masters Distillers (SM)**

Originally released for Travel Retail, Glenlivet Master Distiller's Reserve Small Batch is crafted with specially selected casks, including first-fill ex-Sherry, American oak, and traditional oak casks. Expect fresh oak spice, raisin, orange, and oily barley notes.

## **Glenlivet Nadurra 16Y (SM)**

Nadurra, meaning 'Natural' in Gaelic, embodies the pure essence of Glenlivet's cask-strength 16-year-old whisky. Aged exclusively in first-fill American oak casks, it is bottled at cask strength and non-chill filtered, preserving its bold and natural character. Expect notes of ripe orchard fruits, creamy vanilla, honey, and warming spice, with a rich, lingering finish.

## **Glenlivet Tripple Cask (SM)**

Matured in a combination of traditional oak, American white oak, and ex-sherry casks, creating a rich and layered profile. Expect notes of ripe fruit, creamy toffee, vanilla, and warm spice, with a smooth, well-rounded finish.

## **Glenmoray 12Y (SM)**

The flagship Glen Moray from the Elgin Heritage range, this 12-year-old is aged exclusively in American oak casks, it offers a pleasing, Speyside single malt with chewy barley, a drizzle of syrup, a hint of apricot, and crushed honey-roasted nuts.

## **Glenrothes Manse Reserve (SM)**

Originally a travel retail exclusive, Glenrothes Manse Reserve is now available to all. Aged in a combination of American oak and sherry-seasoned casks, it delivers a rich, smooth character with notes of dried fruit, vanilla, honey, and warm spice, finishing with a hint of oak and citrus zest.

## **Glenrothes Robur Reserve (SM)**

Named after the European Spanish oak, Quercus Robur, this whisky is aged in first-fill Oloroso sherry casks. Expect sweet spices, nutmeg, prune juice, a hint of uncooked pastry, golden syrup, and a touch of Demerara rum.

## **Glenrothes Select Reserve (SM)**

Added to Glenrothes' core range in 2010. Matured in a combination of American oak and sherry-seasoned casks, it delivers a smooth, well-balanced profile with notes of ripe fruit, vanilla, honey, and gentle spice, leading to a soft, malty finish. a hint of herb.

## **Glenrothes Vintage Reserve (SM)**

Made with rare Glenrothes vintage whiskies from 1989 to 2007, the Glenrothes Vintage Reserve is a luxurious, deeply flavoured expression. Matured in both American oak and sherry-seasoned casks creating a smooth yet complex profile. Expect notes of dried fruit, honey, vanilla, and warm spice, with a rich, well-rounded finish.

## **Monkey Shoulder (B)**

A smooth blend of the finest single malt whiskies (Balvenie, Glenfiddich, and Kininvie), crafted in small batches. Aged in ex-bourbon casks, it delivers a smooth, rich profile with notes of vanilla, honey, spice, and toasted malt, making it a versatile whisky for sipping or cocktails.

## **Speyburn Brandan Orach (SM)**

Bradán Orach, Gaelic for "Golden Salmon," is an award-winning whiskey with 7 prestigious accolades. Aged in ex-bourbon casks. It offers a fruity, balanced profile with creamy vanilla, subtle spice, and oak notes for a rich, smooth experience.

## **Tamnavulin Double (SM)**

The perfect introduction to Tamnavulin single malts. It is first matured in American oak barrels before being finished in sherry casks, creating a smooth, rich profile with notes of caramel, dried fruit, vanilla, and warm spice, leading to a soft, well-balanced finish.

## **Tamnavulin Oloroso (SM)**

A premium single malt from the heart of Speyside, Initially matured in American oak barrels before being finished in Oloroso sherry casks, creating a rich, smooth profile with notes of dried fruit, dark chocolate, caramel, and warm spice, leading to a velvety, well-rounded finish.

## **Tamnavulin Sauvignon (SM)**

A unique blend of Sauvignon Blanc and Semillon wine flavours with Speyside single malt. It is first matured in American oak barrels before being finished in Sauvignon Blanc wine casks creating a fresh, vibrant profile with notes of crisp green apple, citrus, pear, and vanilla, balanced by a light, fruity sweetness.

## **Tamnavulin Tempra (SM)**

Initially matured in American oak barrels, it is finished in Tempranillo red wine casks, giving it a rich, fruity character. Expect notes of red berries, dark chocolate, honey, and warm spice, with a smooth, velvety finish.

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## **The Singleton 12Y (SM)**

With Versions produced at Dufftown, Glendullan, and Glen Ord distilleries, depending on the market. Aged in a combination of ex-bourbon and sherry-seasoned casks, it offers a smooth, well-balanced profile with notes of honey, ripe fruit, nuts, and a hint of spice, leading to a soft, lingering finish.

## **The Singleton 15Y (SM)**

Produced at Dufftown, Glendullan, or Glen Ord distilleries, depending on the market. Aged in a mix of ex-bourbon and sherry-seasoned casks, it delivers a rich, smooth profile with notes of dried fruit, honey, toasted nuts, and warm spice, leading to a long, well-rounded finish.

## **The Singleton Malt Masters (SM)**

Hand-selected and blended, this whisky is matured in a mix of European and American oak casks, including ex-wine, ex-sherry, and ex-bourbon. The slightly oily palate is rich with sweet toffee, vanilla, pear drops, with a grassy undertone and a vibrant, youthful spice that lingers throughout

## **Tomintoul 16Y (SM)**

Lovingly crafted from the finest American oak ex-bourbon casks, this whisky is nutty and well-rounded, with layers of crème brûlée, boiled sweets, and subtle hints of mocha and amaretto biscuit.

## **Tomintoul Tundra (SM)**

An elegant, balanced, and creamy single malt, matured entirely in American oak bourbon barrels. It offers nutty, creamy notes with layers of vanilla fudge, stone fruits, and crème anglaise.

## Islands

### **Arran 10Y (Isle of Arran) (SM)**

A single malt that captures the essence of the Isle of Arran, with rich vanilla sweetness, a touch of cinnamon, and a soft texture. Age rounds the classic citrus notes, unveiling deeper layers of sweet oak, green fruits, and apple peel.

### **Island Old Scotch (Guernsey) (B)**

A rare, edition from Guernsey, blended by Randalls Brewery over 20 years ago for mixing—no tasting notes, but its aged character might just surprise you. Give it a go!

### **Jura 10Y (Isle of Jura) (SM)**

A whisky only Jura could make, born on the island and crafted in tall stills. Matured for 10 years in American White Oak ex-bourbon barrels, then finished in Oloroso sherry casks. Expect rich notes of nectarines, ginger, coffee, and toasted almonds.

### **Jura 14Y (Isle of Jura) (SM)**

Matured in American white oak ex-bourbon and hand-selected American Rye barrels, this 14-year-old single malt offers depth and complexity with layered spices, aromatic herbs, and floral notes. On the palate, enjoy toffee apple richness, pecan pie, cinnamon, vanilla, honey, cacao, and hazelnut.

### **Jura Islander's Expressions (Isle of Jura) (SM)**

Finished in hand selected Scottish Pale Ale Casks, this whisky offers layers of tropical fruit flavours and aromatic hops. Soft, bitter-sweet citrus notes and hints of tropical fruit balanced with pine and vanilla spice.

### **Jura Rum cask finish (Isle of Jura) (SM)**

Exploring the world of cask finishes from the Caribbean, this smooth yet vibrant whisky offers sweet vanilla, fudge, coconut, and spiced tropical notes. Currently, it's only available in the UK.

### **Jura The Sound (Isle of Jura) (SM)**

Initially matured in ex-bourbon casks and finished in 15-year-old Pedro Ximénez sherry casks, this whisky offers notes of maple syrup drizzled over hazelnuts, followed by warming winter Flavors of orange peel and black forest fruits.

### **Talisker 10Y (Isle of Skye) (SM)**

A classic Island whisky from the Isle of Skye, aged in American oak casks. It combines warm peat, coastal air, crackling bonfire smoke, black pepper, orchard fruit, and a hint of brine—making it a spectacular after-dinner dram.

### **Talisker Dark Storm (Isle of Skye) (SM)**

Matured in heavily charred oak casks, this intensely smoky whisky delivers a huge oak influence and a bold burst of smoke. Underneath, you'll discover red fruit, citrus, and fresh honey.

### **Talisker Skye (Isle of Skye) (SM)**

Launched in 2015, this smooth, sweet whisky offers citrus, sweet smoke, peppery spice, and maritime notes. Aged in a mix of refill and toasted American oak casks, it features honeyed oak, apple turnovers, fennel seeds, and hints of lemon-lime Opal Fruits

### **Tobermory 12Y Isle of Mull (SM)**

Released in early 2019, this 12-year-old expression is matured in American oak. Featuring bright notes of orchard fruit and malt greet the nose, followed by a rich, oily palate of stone fruit sweetness and a warm finish of orange peel, toffee, and spice.

## Islay

### **Ardberg 10Y (SM)**

Renowned as the peatiest, smokiest, and most complex single malt, Ardbeg Ten offers perfect balance. Bursting with crackling peat, tangy lemon, black pepper, and cinnamon-spiced toffee, followed by brine, smooth buttermilk, ripe bananas, and currants.

### **Bowmore 12Y (SM)**

The heart of the Bowmore range, this whisky showcases beautiful coastal notes and gentle peat, balanced by floral elements. Rounded and honeyed initially, it evolves with vanilla, perfumed smoke, dark peat, blossom, and oily sweetness.

### **Bruichladdich, Classic Laddie (SM)**

This flagship unpeated single malt, made with 100% carefully selected Scottish barley, offers a refreshing whisky with fruity, floral notes of red apples, white

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grapes, sweet cinnamon, and brown sugar, all rounded off with a hint of coastal softness.

## **Bunnahabhain Eirigh Na Greine (SM)**

Meaning “*Morning Sky*” in Gaelic, this expression features red wine cask maturation, bringing juicy berry notes that blend with sea salt, orchard fruit, apricot, black pepper, and a delightful wine cask sweetness.

## **Lagavulin 8Y (SM)**

Released to commemorate the 200th anniversary of the founding of Lagavulin distillery by John Johnston in 1816, this eight-year-old is big and smoky, with sweet spice that becomes apparent with a drop of water.

## **Laphroaig 10Y (SM)**

Laphroaig 10-Year-Old is an iconic Islay single malt known for its bold, heavily peated character. Matured in bourbon barrels, it offers intense smoke, seaweed, and a touch of spice. Renowned for its complexity and distinctive flavour, this whisky captures the true spirit of Islay.

## **Laphroaig Four Oak (SM)**

Laphroaig Four Oak blends smoky peat with vanilla and subtle cookie dough sweetness, thanks to its unique mix of casks—ex-bourbon, quarter casks, virgin American oak, and European oak. A rich, layered dram!

## Highlands

### **Aberfeldy 12Y (SM)**

A smooth sweet Highland whisky with honeyed fruit, gentle smoke, and a silky texture. Flavors of vanilla fudge, peaches and cream, and subtle oak make it a laid-back, easy sipper.

### **Ancnoc Black Hill Reserve (SM)**

Launched in 2015 and named after the distillery’s Gaelic roots, a rich single malt matured in first-fill ex-bourbon casks. It offers vibrant apple and orange notes, complemented by bourbon vanilla and a touch of cooking spice.

### **Ardmore Peated (SM)**

Relaunched by Beam Global in 2014 as its first official bottling in years. Initially aged in American oak barrels and finished in quarter casks, it combines vanilla and barley sugar sweetness with earthy peat.

### **Balblair 2004 1st Release (SM)**

The Balblair 2004 vintage, bottled in 2017 after 12 years in bourbon casks, is a captivating Highland dram. It bursts with the signature toffee and vanilla flavours, enriched by a delightful spice from the malt and a deep, oaky warmth.

### **Dalwhinnie 15Y**

known for its gentle, high-value whiskies. Aged in bourbon and oloroso sherry casks, it offers malty richness with walnuts in manuka honey, vanilla sponge, and a hint of smoke. The clean, crisp profile is rounded off with a touch of spice.

### **Dalmore 12Y (SM)**

Launched in late 2008, Dalmore’s 12-year-old single

malt is a rich, toasty dram with coffee, spice, and a thick mouthfeel. It features notes of Seville marmalade, triple sec, winter spices, fruitcake, zesty cocoa, and milk chocolate.

### **Dalmore Valour (SM)**

A rich and smooth single malt Scotch, aged in a mix of American oak and Oloroso sherry casks. With flavours of dried fruit, honey, vanilla, and a touch of chocolate, it offers a balanced and luxurious drinking experience at an accessible price.

### **Fettercairn 12Y**

Originally established in 1824, the distillery is famed for its unique water-jacketed stills producing a light, fruity spirit. This expression is soft and rounded, with milk chocolate, sweet cream, and gentle spice, making for a beautifully complex whisky.

### **Fettercairn For**

Marking the distillery’s rebirth in 2010, Fettercairn Fior blends 15% heavily-peated whisky with 14- and 15-year-old spirit, resulting in a bold, complex dram with rich flavours of cocoa, espresso, spices, fruit, and almond.

### **Glen Deveron 16Y**

The 16-year-old single malt from Macduff’s official range was initially released for the Travel Retail market features chewy cereal notes and green apple, complemented by a subtle, elegant hint of peat smoke.

### **Glen Garioch Founders Reserve**

### **Glen Turner Double Cask**

The Glen Turner Heritage Double Cask, from Glen Moray, is finished in port wine casks after six years. It features sweet vanilla, caramel, toffee, cinnamon cookies, and fruit jellies, showcasing over 100 years of whisky-making expertise.

### **Glendronach 10Y**

A richly sherried single malt matured for a decade in Pedro Ximenez and Oloroso sherry casks. It offers flavours of Valencia orange, blackcurrants, toffee praline, tobacco, nutmeg, and brambles.

### **Glendronach 12Y**

A dense, heavily sherried dram matured in Oloroso and Pedro Ximenez casks. Bold spice and sweetness make it perfect for after-dinner sipping, with flavours of toffee, apples, vanilla, and dark fruits.

### **Glenmorangie Original**

Founded in 1843 by William and Anne Matheson, their legacy lives on today. This single malt, packed with vanilla, citrus, honey, and peach, won a gold medal at the 2024 World Whiskies Awards, blending tradition with extraordinary flavour.

### **Loch Lomond 10Y**

Distilled in Straight Neck stills, fermented for three weeks, and aged for 10 years in American Oak casks, this whisky boasts aromas of peach, honey, and

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grapefruit. The palate offers vanilla sweetness, lemon citrus, and tropical fruit.

## **Loch Lomond 12Y**

Crafted near Ben Lomond with unique Straight Neck and traditional Swan Neck stills, and aged in bourbon, refill, and re-charred American Oak casks. It offers notes of peach and pear, layered with vanilla sweetness and a subtle hint of smoke.

## **Oban Little Bay (SM)**

With two centuries of craftsmanship and authenticity, this whisky is bold and complex. It boasts luscious notes of Christmas pudding, citrus, and spice, finishing with a rich dark chocolate note.

## **Old Pulteney Noss Head (SM)**

Inspired by Noss Head lighthouse near Wick in Caithness, this Old Pulteney single malt reveals subtle maritime notes. Matured in American Oak ex-bourbon casks, it delivers a full-bodied, sweet and spicy taste with a long-lasting finish.

## **Royal Brackla 12Y (SM)**

The Royal Brackla distillery in Cawdor was the first to receive the "Royal" title. The 2015 release, Royal Brackla 12-Year-Old, is finished in first-fill Oloroso sherry casks, offering a light and spicy profile with notes of vanilla and black pepper.

## **Royal Lochnagar 12Y (SM)**

From a distillery at the foot of the Cairngorm mountains, a mile from Balmoral Castle, this delicate malt features notes of fruit, planed wood, and toffee, with a sweet palate that builds in acidity.

## **Scapa The Orcadian (SM)**

A unique single malt Scotch whisky from the remote Scapa Distillery on the Orkney Islands. First fill American Oak Casks. Soft and creamy with sweet malt notes, caramelized lemon, tropical fruits and a subtle oak note.

## **Shackleton (B)**

A Blended Malt Scotch, inspired by the spirit supplied to the 1907 British Antarctic Expedition, is crafted from fine Highland Single Malts. It offers bold, rich flavours of dark sugar, dried fruits, and glazed pineapple.

## **Strathisla 12Y (SM)**

## **Tullibardine 225 (SM)**

The distillery's history dates back to 1488, when King James IV bought beer on site it was converted to a whisky distillery in 1947. Tullibardine 225 features tropical pineapple, orange zest, and a creamy finish.

## **Irish**

### **Bushmills Irish Malt 10Y (N. Ireland) (SM)**

Bushmills, the world's oldest licensed distillery since 1608, presents the 10-Year-Old—a blend of single malts matured in bourbon barrels and sherry butts. It features a fresh, zesty nose with notes of ripe fruit, vanilla, and toasted wood.

### **Connemara (Dublin) (SM)**

Connemara is the only widely available peated single malt whiskey, inspired by the 18th-century tradition of drying malting barley over peat fires. It offers a distinct peaty flavour, with a delicate smokiness and smooth sweetness.

### **Greenore 8Y (Dublin) (SM)**

### **Jameson (Dublin) (B)**

Look closely at the bottle, you'll see the Barrelman icon, symbolizing the hardworking individuals who built Jameson's whiskey. Made from a mix of single pot still whiskey and grain whiskey. Triple-distilled for smoothness and aged in ex-bourbon and sherry casks, it offers a well-balanced profile with notes of vanilla, honey, toasted wood, and soft spice, leading to a smooth, mellow finish.

### **Jameson IPA (Dublin) (B)**

Jameson IPA (Irish Pale Ale) is crafted for craft beer lovers and curious whiskey drinkers. It offers hops, light citrus, sweet herbal notes, and delicate spicy tones.

### **Jameson Triple Triple (Dublin) (B)**

Triple Distilled, Triple Cask... and some say, Triple Smooth. Luscious and textured, it offers notes of creamy fudge and vanilla, with mild nutty undertones and gentle wood spices.

### **Kilbeggan 8Y (Kilbeggan) (SG)**

Opened in 1757 and closed in 1953. Distilling resumed in 2007 after the Kilbeggan Preservation and Development Association was formed in 1982. Offering a traditional Irish taste with smooth, silky sweet honey and a spicy malt undertone.

### **Locke's 8Y (Kilbeggan) (SM & SG)**

Produced at the Cooley Distillery, now owned by Suntory Global Spirits, this whiskey features big, succulent barley with a copper tanginess, followed by a dry, fruity flavour.

### **Powers Distiller's cut (Dublin) (B)**

Cut from the heart of the distillate, with more top and tail discarded than any other Irish whiskey, this expression matures in selected American oak casks,

## **Slane Triple Casked (Slane, Co Meath) (B)**

## **Tullamore D.E.W Caribbean Cask (Tullamore, Co.Offaly) (B)**

This whiskey honours Irish immigrants' influence on Caribbean rum. Aged in rum casks, it delivers tropical flavours. Expect notes of toffee, vanilla, banana, coconut, and soft spice, with a smooth, slightly sweet finish. This expression adds an exotic twist to Tullamore D.E.W.'s signature smooth style.

## **Tullamore D.E.W Triple Distilled (Tullamore, Co.Offaly) (B)**

### **Rittenhouse (Kentucky)**

A bold and flavourful rye whiskey, known for its rich spiciness, with notes of caramel, vanilla, and a touch of oak. Bottled at a high proof, it delivers a robust, full-bodied experience.

### **Wild Turkey 101 (Kentucky)**

## **Pike Creek (Canada) (B)**

Finished in rum barrels, this whisky offers old-fashioned cola cubes, cardamom heat, caramel, and a clear hint of quality rum, following a shift from its previous Port cask finish in the 2010s.

## **Rampur (India) (SM)**

A luxurious Indian single malt with rich notes of oak, honey, and dried fruit, offering a smooth and memorable sipping experience. Winner of many international awards including the Double Gold Medal San Francisco, USA

## **Roc' Elf (France) (SM)**

Distilled in Dinan, Brittany. Aged for 5 to 6 years in oak barrels from Coteau du Layon, finished in beer barrels from the same distillery – Brasserie Sainte Colombe. It offers creamy, malty notes with light spices, apple, and a toasted finish.

## **Rozelieures Fume (France) (SM)**

This French peated whisky, aged in fino sherry casks, offers velvety smoke layered with roasted nuts, aromatic spice, and orchard fruit.

## **Rozelieures Single Malt (France) (SM)**

Distilled in two squat Charentais pot stills, this whisky boasts a rich, rounded style. Aged in sherry and ex-Cognac casks, it offers notes of ripe pears, candied fruits, spice, leather, and nuts.

## **Slyrs Bavarian Single Malt (Germany) (SM)**

A mild malty taste with fruity aromas with a long and intense spicy finish with light smoke aromas of the toasted barrel. The 2015 World Whiskey Awards winner of "Best European Single Malt 12 years and under".

## **Starward Left Field (Australia) (SM)**

Left Field, a well-rounded single malt from Australian distillery Starward, is matured in Australian Red Wine barrels. It offers rich notes of sultanas, ginger cake, blackcurrants, dark chocolate, and stewed fruit throughout the palate.

## **Starward Two Fold (Australia) (B)**

Crafted using malted barley and wheat, then matured entirely in Australian red wine casks. It offers soft vanilla fudge, coffee and walnut cake, summer berries, and stewed stone fruit.

## **Stauning Host (Danish) (SM)**

Pronounced "Hurst" (Danish for "Harvest"), this whisky is matured in heavily charred American oak and first-fill Port barrels. It offers a well-balanced, smooth, and fruity profile with delicate floral undertones.

## **Tácnbora (Northumberland England) (B)**

Tácnbora, (means "Standard Bearer" in Old English) made at Ad Gefrin Distillery in Northumberland blends Scottish and Irish whiskies aged in a mix of bourbon, virgin American oak, and Oloroso casks. The result is a rich profile of caramel Digestives, cinnamon, vanilla pods, and hazelnuts.

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# Descriptive Whisky List

## **Three Ships Bourbon Cask (South Africa) (SM)**

First released in 2005 this blended whisky of 100% South African whisky is finished in Bourbon casks to give a soft honeyed sweetness with vanilla notes and subtle hints of pepper and spice.

## **Woodcutters Daughter (England) (SM)**

Blending traditional whiskey distilling with New World techniques, this whisky offers a unique flavour. Inspired by the Silent Pool legend, it features floral and

berry notes on the palate, with hints of vanilla and honey.

## **Yushan (Taiwan) (SM)**

This Taiwanese blended malt, named after Taiwan's highest mountain, is crafted by the makers of Omar single malts. It offers creamy vanilla and tangy orange, complemented by rounded malt and buttery biscuit notes.
